SBCTC Enterprise Technology Services Data Staging Area – SQL



DSA-S Overview

The SQL Data Staging Area (DSA-S) provides each college with access to their college data that is stored in the SQL databases hosted at the State Data Center by the State Board for Community and Technical Colleges. Data may be extracted from the DSA-S to the college campuses using a SQL Server Linked Server. The DSA-S has been developed to become your data source to populate your locally hosted data staging area.

The SBCTC Upload Engine (SUE) will be used to distribute database scripts that may be useful when creating your staging databases. This will include scripts to add tables to your staging database and scripts to apply any subsequent schema changes that correspond to changes applied to the OLTP Production and DSA-S schemas.

Prerequisites

To use the SQL Data Staging Area (DSA-S), you will need to have a target SQL database (either SQL 2005 and 2008) on a server at your college. The *Linked Server for OLE DB Access* data provider that is part of all SQL Server installations will be used to create Linked Servers for DSA-S access.

For your college to gain access to the DSA-S environment:

- 1. Create a SQL staging database on your campus. Contact the <u>SBCTC-ITD Service Desk</u> to request access to the SUE Upload site for SQL scripts to add the tables. You will receive the following:
 - a. College *SUE User* account name and password for access to the SUE upload site for database scripts
- 2. Access the DSA-S environment. Contact the <u>SBCTC-ITD Service Desk</u> to request access to the DSA-S environment, provide the following details:
 - a. The name and contact information (email address and phone number) of your college's team members that will be accessing the DSA-S
 - b. The IP Address of the server on your campus that you will be using as your data staging server to extract data from DSA-S
- 3. The SBCTC will update the network rules and activate your account. Once activated, you will receive the following:
 - a. IP address for the DSA-S server
 - b. College SQL User account name and password for access to your DSA-S databases

Data Availability

The data in the DSA-S environment is replicated from the SQL Production (OLTP) databases in nearly real time. The DSA-S portion of this solution is the responsibility of SBCTC to maintain. This has been installed and configured to provide access to the Degree Audit and Financial Aid databases for each college's data.
