

STATE OF WASHINGTON STATE BOARD FOR COMMUNITY AND TECHNICAL COLLEGES RESOLUTION 24-08-49

A resolution relating to the development of the 2025-27 operating budget request:

WHEREAS, RCW 28B.50.090 authorizes the State Board to prepare a single budget for the support of the state system of community and technical colleges; and

WHEREAS, the State Board has determined that the community and technical colleges are uniquely positioned to provide talented graduates to fill new jobs in Washington's dynamic economy; and

WHEREAS, the State Board has determined that meeting the state's post-secondary attainment goals and workforce needs requires both adequate and stable funding to support the core campus operations as described in Tab 2 of the August 29, 2024 meeting material.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the State Board for Community and Technical Colleges approves and directs the State Board staff to prepare the community and technical college system biennial operating budget request as set forth in Tab 2 – Consideration of the 2025-27 Operating Budget Request.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the State Board for Community and Technical Colleges authorizes the Executive Director to make adjustments to this action, including any necessary changes to the State Board's Policy Manual, as necessary, for actions taken by the Governor, Legislature, data corrections, externally imposed restrictions or guidelines, uniform accounting and reporting requirements, and unanticipated changes in state or federal law.
