#### Legislative Update

- Governor's 2023-25 Operating Budget
  - Hybrid-Flex wasn't approved or included in the Governor's budget
    - Have talked about the need for these things – being careful since it's not included in the budget
  - Technology-related bills – there's a possibility of continuation of bills from the last couple years
    - Cybersecurity
    - Automated Decision Making Tools

#### PMO & Working Group Update

- Financial Aid progress
  - Published project information guide
  - Addressing remaining issues in colleges – significant differences in each college's processes and policies
  - Grant taking the issue to WACTC Tech meeting on January 24<sup>th</sup> asking presidents to give a decision or statement of acknowledgment to move forward with aligning the processes and policies for all colleges
  - Grant shared WSAC policy decision that reduces Financial Aid administrative burden for WCG awards
- Proxy votes from Working Group
  - STAC agreed it would be okay to give vote to anyone attending who had knowledge of the issue or area they are voting on if a working group member was absent

## Sub-Group Updates

- CATO – No update
- EdTech
  - Starting work on Cooperative Purchasing
    - Panopto & Canvas expiring 6/30/2023
    - Sending survey out asking if colleges want to continue using, and if not, what are the issues
    - How are we going to make the decision
    - Pricing
- ctLink College Collaboration Group
  - Jason reported that the meetings are well done and well attended
  - Have taken on some things that are too large
    - Working on aligning how to process the needs of the colleges and what items should go through this process
    - Can STAC help with prioritizing
    - How are we going to make the decision

## STAC Work Plan for Coming Year

- Help Committees/Councils align their work plans
  - Need to provide guidance for bringing forward discussion - formalize way to get the feedback
  - Identify that Technology is at the table all of the time with everything we do
  - Continue to work on Governance processes and work plan structure
- STAC Governance Process
  - Bring Gartner in for Hype Cycle
  - Grant had a meeting with Gartner representative to get ITC presentation to WACTC Tech in February regarding aligning strategic and STAC items; will then report out at the business meeting with the presidents
