Legislative Update

- Governor's 2023-25 Operating Budget
 - Hybrid-Flex Coursework was not funded
 - Technology-related bills
 - SB5356 – Automate Decision-Making tools
 - SB5518 & HB1464 – Ransomware
- Working Group Charter Amendment (Proxy Voting)
 - STAC moved, seconded, carried to move forward with amendment

Sub-Group Updates

CATO – (Monica Olsson for Ward Naf)

- [Web Accessibility Learning Lab](#) kicks off February 9, 2023
- Seven teams (six colleges and SBCTC) were accepted to participate in this year's cohort.

EdTech

- Submitted the survey for Panopto & Canvas
 - Not changing anything, just getting feedback for vendor

ctcLink College Collaboration Group

- Enhancement Requests
 - Will bring the framework to March STAC meeting

- Took all enhancement requests from Quick Status list and ranked in order of priority
 - have received great response from the colleges
- Book to Bank – two other groups working on this, trying to move groups together
- SBCTC groups need to be more assertive with colleges who aren't responding to requests (e.g., surveys)
 - When sending things out, College Collaboration Representative/ctcLink College Leaders need to send to related SMEs – Their primary role at campus is for them to report out to and coordinate with their SMEs.

STAC Work Plan for Coming Year

- Visit Commissions/Councils
 - Support VPs asking for tools to help them get the information out
 - Help councils better understand process
 - Commissions have several councils under them so information should move from the commissions down
- Work with Commissions & Councils for common work plan structure template
 - Collect data and see where work plans interest (relation to technology especially)
 - Make data available on websites and visible
 - Small work group from STAC members who will work on getting the data and creating template – Brendon Taga, Dave Pelkey, Sherry Nelson
- Getting all charters in place
- Technology Committees
 - How do we engage them in presenting their ideas to STAC
 - How do we give them a voice
 - Define governance for technology and ctcLink
 - Other things from technology committees or work plans to get us to more strategic conversations
- STAC Commissions & Councils Representatives need to bring items to present at STAC meetings.
- Gartner Hype Cycle
 - Gartner will be presenting at the February 23 WACTC-Tech meeting – Sherry will include STAC team in invite for the presentation.
- ChatGPT discussion, awareness and concerns
 - AI Technology - proactive approach to help faculty learn how to use it (see links below from Eva and Marc)
