Welcome, Roll Call 00:00 - 00:06 mins

Welcome & roll call.

Approval for Meeting Minutes from August 3, 2022 00:06 - 00:08 mins

Reuth displayed the meeting minutes and informed that there is a new format: action items will be called out and highlighted in yellow and approvals will be in bold.

August 3, 2022, meeting minutes were approved.

College Co-Chair Discussion 00:09 - 00:11 mins

Chantel Black, Spokane, was approved as the WG college co-chair. Colleges sent an email and discussed this prior to the WG meeting.

Enhancement Requests (ER) 00:11 - 01:30 mins

Maria Sultan, along with CS Support Team presented the **WG Log #146: CS Core - Course Repeat**Management Enhancement Request Discussion Summarized:

ER Overview:

- Introduces new Repeat Codes to be used when a college allows a student to enroll in attempts beyond the maximum
- New repeat codes are configured to be properly counted or excluded in GPA, attempted credit, and FTE calculations
- Aligns repeat and applicable grade configurations across all colleges to adhere to state policy (with some allowable exceptions)
- Removes college edit access to these configurations to maintain consistency with state policy

WG Expressed These Concerns:

Colleges losing edit/update access to Grade Scheme Table

- Analysis: Multiple colleges are currently configured to bypass the repeat rule setup
- Read-only access is consistent with other foundational SACR configurations. These foundational configurations are rarely updated, and college changes can lead to major clean-up
- This helps ensure your FTE calculation is accurate and in compliance with the state policy

Colleges may want to implement a stricter repeat rule of two attempts

- Analysis: One college is currently following a stricter setup
- Stricter setup can be configured on request. Colleges should be aware that this will result in more manual enrollment transactions by staff
- This concern focused on compliance with the DOE, which states:
 - "If the student passes the course, you may include one repetition after passing the course. Any second or subsequent repetition of the passed course may not be included in the student's enrollment status for purposes of the title IV, HEA, programs. [Guidance issued 8/26/2011]"
- Good news there's an FA query for that: QCS_FA_REPEAT_CRSES

Will "I" or "W" grades be considered an attempt?

- Analysis: Two colleges currently set up to exclude "I" grades and 11 colleges currently set up to
 exclude other grades from repeat attempts that should be included based on the state policy
- Yes, these grades will count as attempts and CS will update the configuration to be in compliance. As stated in the SBCTC <u>policy</u>:
 - "A course applies to the repeat rule if the student receives an evaluative (graded) or nonevaluative (withdraw) symbol for the course as counted per census date rules as posted on the transcript."

There was a request for a query to identify enrollment in variable credit courses beyond a third attempt

CS will work with Reporting and other applicable stakeholders to develop a query for this purpose

Colleges need time to review their transcript legends

- Transcripts show the repeat code descriptions, not the repeat code
- Are there any colleges that explain repeat code descriptions in their transcript legend?

Nichole Seroshek, college guest from LCC, provided some input to this ER and looks forward to having more tools to be more in compliance with SBCTC and to manage transcripts correctly for students (example: zeroing out the units and ripple effect to Clearinghouse report and FA SAP).

Action Item: The vote was tabled by WG. WG suggested adjustments are made to the ER (to include more restrictions) that this is taken to College Collaboration Group on 8/24/2022. This will also be discussed at the WG meeting on 9/7/2022.

High Level ER Flows 01:30 - 01:43 mins

Tara displayed the current high level ER flows. Colleges suggested a work group but time is a constraint. Action Item: Tara suggested that her PMO take a stab at drafting a new ER flow and WG members agreed. We will target having a link to a draft by 9/7/2022 and hope to have an approval by 9/21/2022.

Security, Shelia reported: held design requirements meting with the colleges to discuss offboarding (audit compliant, automation). Hope to present this at the College Collaboration Group meeting. Working on a webpage for Security.
