- ER 232 Adding Custom Self-Service Questions in Campus Solutions Carmen McKenzie
 - This was moved from formal to mandated as we have a new process, and this was the first ER to go through it.
 - Questions around FA once she has met with Ana Ybarra and team; biggest issue being housing. FA needs to determine budgets.
 - Also, students attending more than one college, which is very common and making sure the EMPL ID is common across all. Concern is data matching when they update at one college and not the other. Is there a way to make sure data is accurate across all campuses?
 - Great points brought up by group. Carmen and team as well as Data Governance Committee will be meeting to discuss these items further. Carmen will come back to Working Group with updates. More to come.

PMO Updates - (00:57 - 01:02 min)

Tara Keen, PMO, presented the following:

- Sentinel Integration Project
 - Rebranded to Security System Administration Improvement Project (SASI). Ray did cover this in the Security update as we are focusing on our requirement definition through October.
- TouchNet Integration Project-
 - Christyanna Dawson, Brandon Reed, both SBCTC along with 3 colleges attended TouchNet Conference. Was great networking with other colleges and PCI compliance sessions were very helpful.
 - TouchNet will be doing a demo on November 7th.

 - Christyanna is preparing a presentation for BAR on the progress of the TouchNet College Advisory Group (TCAG).
- LegacyLink and Legacy Transcript Application Closeout
 - Did 2nd phase release for Legacy Transcript Application which was last Thursday and are working through final elements to be cleaned up.
 - Then working through project closure procedures as we performed the lesson learned survey process already. Taking that feedback to include in the project closure documentation.
- One Washington AFRS Integration
 - This is an internal project, no college involvement needed. This is a file format focus as many have moved to Workday. We are remaining on our own enterprise system and simply aligning to the new file format.

Mindful Minute (01:02 - 01:18 min)

Tara attended ITC meeting and heard about effort at Peninsula College to work with Okta and our state board agency to do a federated Sign-On share model that would cause their staff to not have to go through the MFA process twice. Other colleges expressed their interest in this to reduce the number of multi-factor engagements in the sign-in process and asked Emma to send the information to them. This way colleges can do MFA process locally and jump into ctcLink straight away versus another MFA. SBCTC network team assisting with that conversation are focusing on colleges that already fully adopted MFA and had deployed for all employees and students. Focusing more on those that use a local instance before focusing on those using another form of multi-factor authentication.

Tara mentioned another item was the Student Success software for Guided Pathways and the work plan being presented to WACTC. Getting the Presidents to decide on a single source rather than supporting multiple student success software platforms or going with HighPoint Mobile as a temporary stop-gap measure.

- Beth stated HighPoint proposal already went to Attorney General (AG) and cost model was prohibitive without an RFP. HighPoint could of course put hat in the ring, but it is not an option with going through protocol. There are more questions than answers and it is voted on at WACTC to move forward with an RFP for a single source. With this votes, it was not clarified if colleges would have an "opt-in" or "opt-out" option.
 - There are a number of 3rd party systems already out there so this is a time for colleges to come together to get on the same page. However, can they say no, I like mine, don't want yours and will continue doing double-data entry for now.

***The goal is a seamless student experience which indicates the need/ask for one system all colleges would use as common process is the goal. This is the focus of our system as a whole and has been. Grant mentioned RFP to be provided in 3-6 months to move forward as that is step 1. A lot to still be discussed along with business process alignment to meet to end goal. More information to come.

Dani shared - Presidents voted on the following resolution: "WACTC endorses and will help enforce the principle that when a common business process can be implemented systemwide, it should be."

This was voted on by the presidents to be supportive of our ctcLink Guiding Principles and to assist colleges and SBCTC with support of common processes when and where they are possible.
