# Introduction

The Image/Upgrade Overview Document is intended to provide ctcLink users with a summary of the changes that will be made in the system as a result of the upcoming image or PeopleTools upgrade implementation. Oracle releases multiple PeopleSoft updates, called images, for each pillar every year. Each Image contains bug fixes and features that are important for PeopleSoft to work well. PeopleTools upgrades update the underlying framework of the system. There are minimal changes that are noticeable to the end users. Below is an overview of the changes that you can expect to see as part of this upgrade.

# Payroll

## Updated Federal / State Tax Table

**Federal (State = \$U)** - The table entry effective-dated 01/01/2024, which was delivered in Tax Update 23-D, is updated to include Federal withholding tax changes effective for wages paid on or after January 1, 2024, as announced by the Internal Revenue Service. <u>https://www.irs.gov/pub/irs-dft/p15t--dft.pdf</u>

**California (CA)** - The table entry effective-dated 01/01/2024, which was delivered in Tax Update 23-D, is updated to include California withholding tax changes effective for wages paid on or after January 1, 2024. <u>https://edd.ca.gov/siteassets/files/pdf\_pub\_ctr/24methb.pdf</u>

**Georgia (GA)** - A new table entry effective-dated 01/01/2024 includes Georgia withholding tax changes effective for wages paid on or after January 1, 2024. <u>https://dor.georgia.gov/employers-tax-guide</u>

**Hawaii (HI)** - The table entry effective-dated 01/01/2024, which was delivered in Tax Update 23-D, is updated to include the following changes for 2024:

- 1. The Hawaii state unemployment insurance taxable wage base increase from \$56,700 to \$59,100. <u>http://labor.hawaii.gov/ui/news/tax-rate-schedule-and-weekly-benefit-amount/</u>
- For tax year 2024, the maximum taxable gross for Hawaii state temporary disability insurance and voluntary plan temporary disability insurance programs is \$71,489 (\$1,374.78 weekly), per the Disability Compensation Division of the Hawaii Department of Labor and Industrial Relations. This is an increase from the tax year 2023 amount of \$68,561 (\$1,318.48 weekly).

The employee tax rate remains unchanged at 0.5% (0.005000). https://labor.hawaii.gov/dcd/files/2019/11/newWBA.pdf

**Idaho (ID)** - A new table entry effective-dated 01/01/2024 includes the Idaho state unemployment insurance taxable wage base increase from \$49,900 to \$53,500. <u>https://www.labor.idaho.gov/businesses/unemployment-tax-rates/</u>

**Illinois (IL)** - The table entry effective-dated 01/01/2024, which was delivered in Tax Update 23-D, is updated to include the following changes for 2024:

- 1. The Illinois state unemployment insurance taxable wage base increase from \$13,271 to \$13,590 for 2024. <u>https://ides.illinois.gov/employer-resources/taxes-reporting/rates.html</u>
- The Illinois annual allowance amount increase from \$2,225 to \$2,425, as announced by the Illinois Department of Revenue. <u>https://ilga.gov/legislation/publicacts/103/PDF/103-0009.pdf</u>

**Indiana (IN)** - A new table entry effective-dated 01/01/2024 includes withholding tax changes published by the Indiana Department of Revenue in Departmental Notice #1 (R43/12-23). <u>https://www.in.gov/dor/files/dn01.pdf</u>

**Minnesota (MN)** - The table entry effective-dated 01/01/2024, which was delivered in Tax Update 23-D, is updated to include the following changes for 2024:

- 1. The Minnesota state unemployment insurance taxable wage base increase from \$40,000 to \$42,000.

**North Carolina (NC)** - A new table entry effective-dated 01/01/2024 includes the following changes for 2024:

**Nebraska (NE)** - The table entry effective-dated 01/01/2024, which was delivered in Tax Update 23-D, is updated to include Nebraska withholding tax changes effective for wages paid on or after January 1, 2024.

**New Mexico (NM)** - A new table entry effective-dated 01/01/2024 includes the following changes for 2024:

**Oregon (OR)** - A new table entry effective-dated 01/01/2024 includes the following changes for 2024:

- 1. The Oregon state unemployment insurance taxable wage base increase from \$50,900 to \$52,800.

- 3. Oregon Paid Family & Medical Leave taxable wage base is increased from \$132,900 to \$168,600.

South Carolina (SC) - A new table entry effective-dated 01/01/2024 includes South Carolina withholding tax changes effective for wages paid on or after January 1, 2024. https://dor.sc.gov/forms-site/Forms/WH1603F\_2024.pdf

**Washington (WA)** - The table entry effective-dated 01/01/2024, which was delivered in Tax Update 23-D, is updated to include the changes in the Medical Leave Insurance – EE Ratio from 0.4952 to 0.5195 and in the Family Leave Insurance – EE Ratio from 0.5048 to 0.4805. The tax rate decreased from 0.008000 to 0.0074000000.

The ratios are derived based on a review of the calculation results from Washington Employment Security Department calculator and may result in occasional penny differences. <a href="https://paidleave.wa.gov/updates/">https://paidleave.wa.gov/updates/</a>

*Note:* This functionality is not used at ctcLink. For WA PFML, college-specific general deductions have been utilized.

### **Local Tax Table Changes**

**Pennsylvania Local Earned Income Tax** – 24-A Tax Update includes updates to Pennsylvania Local Earned Income Tax entries in the Local Tax Table based on data downloaded from the "Real-Time Register" on the website maintained by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Community & Economic Development.
