Introduction

The Image/Upgrade Overview Document is intended to provide ctcLink users with a summary of the accessibility changes that will be made in the system as a result of the upcoming image or PeopleTools upgrade implementation. Oracle releases multiple PeopleSoft updates, called images, for each pillar every year. Each Image contains bug fixes and features that are important for PeopleSoft to work well. PeopleTools upgrades update the underlying framework of the system. There are minimal changes that are noticeable to the end users. Below is an overview of the changes that you can expect to see as part of this upgrade.

Ability to Set the Screen Reader Mode Dynamically

Screen Reader mode can now be turned on temporarily for the current session or for the current and subsequent sessions from the "Enable Screen Reader Mode" link in Action Menu.


Prior to the PeopleTools 8.59 Upgrade

Screen reader mode could be turned on by selecting "My Preferences" submenu under "Actions" Menu on the banner and then setting the "Accessibility Layout" option under "General Settings."




After the PeopleTools 8.59 Upgrade


A new option "Screen Reader in Actions Menu" is added under "General Settings," in addition to "Accessibility Layout" option.



If this option is selected and the Screen Reader mode is off, "Enable Screen Reader Mode" link appears in the Actions menu.



Upon selecting this link, the system will display a prompt with "Yes/No/Cancel" buttons and a message "Screen reader mode will be enabled. Would you like to persist this setting for subsequent sessions?"



If user selects "No" then screen reader mode will be enabled only for the current session and the system will display a confirmation message.



If user selects "Yes" then screen reader mode will be enabled for the "current session and the subsequent sessions" and the system will display a confirmation message.

Confirmation

Screen reader mode is now enabled and remains in effect on subsequent logins. Use the Back button to return to the previous content.



Note: "Enable Screen Reader Mode" link is available on fluid homepages and fluid pages only. While this link is available in most fluid applications, it is not displayed:

- When screen reader mode is already in effect.
- In fluid activity guides, fluid navigation collections, and in My Preferences.
- On classic pages

Enhancements to Keyboard Shortcuts

Additional Keyboard shortcuts are added and Keyboard shortcut for the Keyboard Information page is changed

After the PeopleTools 8.59 Upgrade

Keyboard shortcuts Alt + 1, Alt + 5, Alt + 7, Alt + 8, Alt + / are implemented for fluid applications.

Keyboard shortcut Shift+Ctrl+K for the Keyboard Information page is changed to Alt + K in Tools 8.59 to eliminate conflicts with JAWS and certain browsers. Also, shortcut Ctrl + K will be available for the Keyboard Information page on a Mac.

Note: The key sequences displayed are appropriate for the browser that you are currently signed on with. If you sign on with a different browser (for example, Safari instead of Firefox), then different key sequences may apply.



Adjustments to Support WCAG 2.1: 1.4.11 – Non-Text (Color Contrast ratio of at least 3:1)


Increased Color Contrast While Hovering Over Tiles on Homepage and Menu Items on Navbar

Prior to the PeopleTools 8.59 Upgrade

The hover color (while moving mouse over a tile) on homepage was **light yellow on a light blue background** with contrast ratio 1.18:1 less than the required 3:1. The hover color (while moving mouse over a navigation item) on navbar was **light yellow on a white background** with contrast ratio 1.01:1 less than the required 3:1. Both of these have contrast ratio less than the required 3:1, so WCAG 2.1 non-text contrast compliance test failed in 8.57.



The hover color (while moving mouse over a tile) on homepage does not change but a dark blue border is added around the tile on the background of light blue with contrast ratio 4.4:1 greater than the required 3:1. The hover color (while moving mouse over a navigation item) on navbar is light blue on a white background but a dark blue border is added on the left hand side of the menu item with contrast ratio 4.97:1 greater than the required 3:1. These hover color contrast ratios are greater than the required 3:1, so hover colors on homepage tiles and navbar are WCAG 2.1 non-text contrast compliant in 8.59.



Increased Color Contrast of File Attachment Drag and Drop Area Border

Prior to the PeopleTools 8.59 upgrade, the color contrast for file drop area border failed WCAG 2.1 non-text contrast test.

Navigation

HCM Pillar (non-screen reader mode) > Employee Self Service Homepage > SBCTC Careers > My Job Applications > Add Attachment. Enter Attachment Type as" Other" and Attachment Title as "Test" and click on Continue button.

While dragging the file in the File attachment box drop area, it had **green color border on a light green background** with contrast ratio **1.91:1 less than the required 3:1**, so WCAG 2.1 non-text contrast compliance test failed.



Image: File Attachment Drop Area in Tools 8.59

In 8.59, while dragging the file in the File attachment box drop area, it has **black color border on a white background** with contrast ratio 21:1 greater than the required 3:1, so the File Attachment Drop Area is WCAG 2.1 non-text contrast compliant in 8.59.

Search Page changes for identifying the context of search results

Accessibility Changes on Component Search Pages

Accessibility Issues Below are Corrected in the PeopleTools 8.59 Upgrade

 The assistive technology could not identify the context of the multiple rows delivered by the search results. When a criterion returns no results, the Text "No matching values were found" was not read by assistive technology.







Page Refresh Issue When Esc Button Pressed on Classic Grid Action Menu is Fixed

Changes are made so ESC button closes the Classic Grid Action Menu without losing the focus on Grid Action Menu icon.

Prior to the PeopleTools 8.59 upgrade, if user selected the ESC button on the keyboard it will close the grid action menu but doing so refreshed the page and the user was taken back to the top of the page. In Tools 8.59 ESC button closes the popup menu and the focus remains on the same action menu grid icon.



After the PeopleTools 8.59 Upgrade

After hitting ESC key on the expanded Grid Action Menu, the Menu closes, page does not refresh, and the focus remains on the Grid Action Menu icon.

Search Criteria not Getting Read in Query Manager/Viewer is Fixed

Changes are made so search criteria are read by Screen Reader in Query Manager/Viewer.

Prior to PeopleTools 8.59 upgrade, in Query Manager or Viewer page, screen readers never read the criteria "begins with" even when user tabbed back. This issue is fixed in Tools 8.59. Criteria "begins with" is read along with the search field value.

Homepage Header Not Readable Issue is Fixed

The homepage name will be included in the page heading so screen reader users can easily identify the homepage selected.


HCM Pillar > Employee Self Service homepage

Prior to the PeopleTools 8.59 Upgrade

"Homepage tiles" was listed as Header 1 instead of the selected homepage header.



After 8.59 home page header (e.g., Employee Self Service) will be listed as Header 1 so screen reader users will be able to identify the selected home page.
