SHB 1316: Running Start

SHB 1316: Expanding Access to Dual Credit Programs

- Increases combined maximum enrollment of, school districts and institutions of higher education, from 1.20 to 1.40 full time equivalents (FTE)
- Opens summer quarter for a max of 10 credits (incl. "rising juniors") if students have remaining FTE available after fall, winter, and spring enrollment
- Requires all school districts to give RS access for ALL eligible students, with an emphasis on students in homeschooled instruction and private schools

After-Exit Running Start Proviso

SSB 5187, Sec. 520(2)(i): Graduation Success and Preparation for Postsecondary Pathways

- \$3M for summer Running Start
- Graduating seniors only ~ must stay enrolled through summer
- Met maximum RS enrollment limits
- 15 credits from AA degree
- Enrolled at CTCs only to complete classes for AA



SSB 5048: College in the High School

SSB 5048: Eliminating College in the High School (CiHS) Fees

- Beginning fall 2023, eliminates CiHS fees to student attending a public/tribal/charter high school and enrolled in CiHS offered through a public college or university.
- No cap on the number of credits
- Funding formula = \$300 per student; maximum \$6,000 for state universities, \$5,000 for comprehensive universities/Evergreen, \$3,500 for CTCs.
- Requires high schools to provide notification to families about the changes in fees and transcript of credit.
- Requires IHEs grant undergraduate college credit as appropriate and applicable to degree requirements and provide course equivalencies for CiHS courses offered.
- Requires an annual legislative report on CiHS enrollment and outcomes.



CTE Dual Credit Pilot and Advisory Cmte.

SSB 5187, Sec. 605(47)

- \$700,000 for 3-CTC Pilot in ESD 189
- Subsidies, outreach, equipment/supplies, articulation and curriculum development
- Advisory Committee: model articulation agreements, data collection/reporting, credit transcription/transfer, student advising, alignment w/ pathways and in-demand fields, IRC attainment, priority courses/programs, SERS

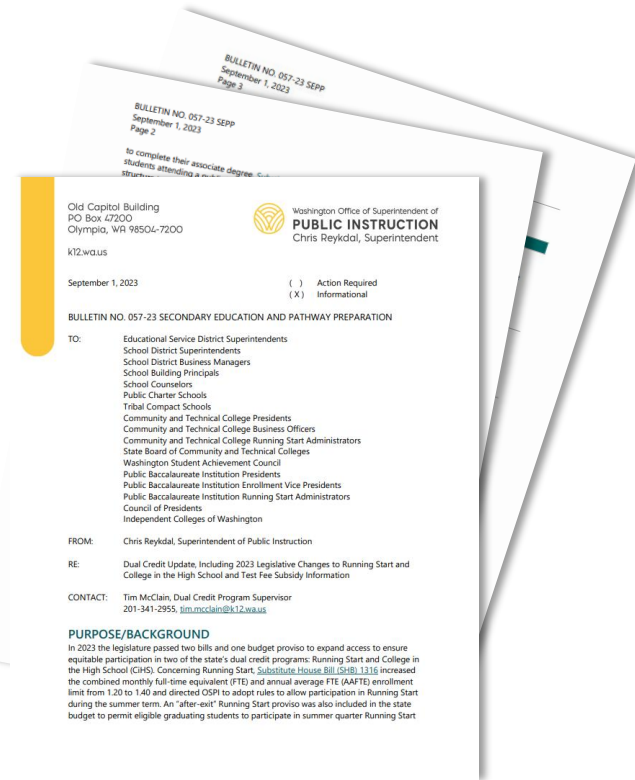
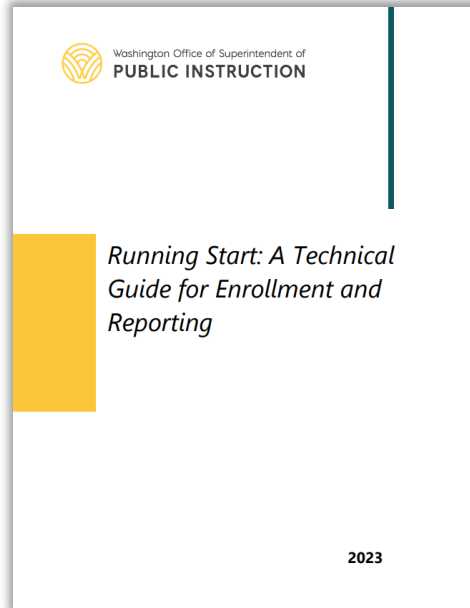

PURPOSE = Increase equitable access to dual credit programs in the most sustainable ways possible

- No more CHS subsidies → now a formula-based, directed grant
- Survey required for eligibility
