Operating Budget Estimate

If the system's operating budget request of \$353 million is fully funded, Big Bend Community College will receive approximately \$2.4 million in additional funding.

Capital Budget Estimate

If the system's request is fully funded, Big Bend Community College will receive approximately \$5,805,200 for operation, maintenance, infrastructure, repairs and minor improvements of its existing facilities, and \$31,953,000 for design and construction of the Health Science and Performing Arts Center.
